#### Prayer

- 1) The Great Disappointment
  - a) A misunderstanding of Daniel 8:14
    - i) The sanctuary was not the earth, but the sanctuary in heaven.
    - ii) Revelation 10:8-11
    - iii) How can we recover from times of bitter disappointment?
  - b) Prophecy again
    - i) Revelation 10:11
    - ii) Rev 14:6-7 – the hour of His judgment is come
- 2) The message of the First Angel's message – Rev 14:6-7
  - a) What does it mean to "fear God"?
    - i) Rev 11:18
    - ii) Rev 15:4
    - iii) Psalm 34:7-11

- iv) Some are afraid of God (Heb 10:31) while others reverence God. What makes the difference?
      - v) What helped you to grow in your relationship with God to a place where you revered God rather than being afraid of Him? 1 John 4:17-19
  - b) What judgment is referred to in Rev 14:7?
    - i) Same as the judgment in Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14
    - ii) Beginning at the end of the 2300 days of Daniel 8:14 –a time of cleansing, vindication and restoration.
    - iii) Concluded by the time of the second coming of Jesus – Rev 22:11-12
  - c) Worship the Creator - Rev 14:7
    - i) How does keeping the commandments of God relate to worshipping God as Creator? Rev 14:12
    - ii) 2 Peter 3:5-7; Exodus 20:8-11
    - iii) Many are abandoning the Bible teaching of God as Creator. How does this cultural shift reinforce the need for the message of the first angel of Rev 14?
- 3) The message of the Second and Third Angels of Rev 14
  - a) Revelation 14:8-11
    - i) Where do we first hear about Babylon?
    - ii) What does "Babylon" represent?
  - b) Rather than focus on the intimidating threats of the beast power, what should the saints do?

    - ii) Rev 14:12; Hebrews 12:1-2
    - iii) Rev 18:4-5
  - c) Where is the Good News in these messages?
