

1. The First Angel's Message

- a) Revelation 14:6 Why is the message of the first angel called "the everlasting gospel", not just "the gospel"?
- b) Who needs to hear the message of the first angel? (See also Mark 16:15-16; Acts 1:8; Matthew 24:14)
- c) Where do you see urgency portrayed in the description of the first angel? (Revelation 14:6-7a)
- d) Who does this first angel represent?
- e) How can we maintain a sense of urgency about proclaiming the everlasting gospel in these last days of earth's history?
- f) What message does this first angel bring, in addition to the everlasting gospel? Revelation 14:7
 - i) What does it mean to fear God? Proverbs 9:10; Revelation 19:5-7
 - ii) What does it mean to give glory to Him? 1 Corinthians 10:31
 - iii) What can we learn from the announcement that "the hour of His judgment has come"?
 - iv) Why is it important to always present the judgment hour message in the context of the everlasting gospel? Revelation 14:6-7
 - v) Obedience to God's commandments (Revelation 14:12) is a key sign of our loyalty to Him and love for Him (John 14:15). Why is the Sabbath commandment particularly important in the context of the first angel's message?

- vi) What are some other ways we can worship God as our Creator besides remembering His Sabbath day to keep it holy?
