

1. An urgent need for physical healing

- a) Mark 2:1-4 What impresses you as you listen to this story?
- b) What need for healing is most obvious here?
- c) Share a time when you experienced a major health challenge. Who was a revelation of God's love and care during that difficult time?

2. Spiritual healing

- a) Mark 2:5 What can we learn from the words of Jesus when the paralytic was laid at His feet?
- b) How did the paralytic respond? (surrender, then obedience – Mark 2:12)
- c) Share your testimony of a time when you needed spiritual healing.

3. Healing from depression

- a) Elijah:
 - i) 1 Kings 19:1-4 What are some factors that might have brought Elijah to such a depressed mental state?
 - ii) What encouragement do you find in the response of the LORD to Elijah's desperate prayer? 1 Kings 19:5-8, 9-18 (see also 2 Kings 2:11)
- b) Invalid at the Pool of Bethesda
 - i) John 5:2,5-7 What does the response of this invalid at the Pool of Bethesda reveal about his mental condition?

- ii) How did Jesus respond? v.8

- c) In both stories, there is no condemnation. Why is it important to recognize God's love and acceptance when we are struggling with anxiety or depression?
- d) Share some Bible passages that offer encouragement during a time of anxiety or depression. Psalm 50:15, Lamentations 3:22-26, Philippians 4:6-7, etc.

4. Hindrances to personal healing

- a) People – Mark 2:6-11 (see also Luke 18:35-39) What are some other ways people might hinder our path to personal healing?
- b) Refusal to have faith – Mark 2:5, 5:34, Luke 18:42 How much faith is necessary to experience the personal healing God's desires for us?
- c) Guilt – "It's my fault. This sickness is the result of my own poor choices." How would you respond?
- d) Ignorance – How can we help people become aware of the fact that God is willing and able to make them whole?
- e) How can we stay open to God's will as we cry out for healing, for ourselves or someone we love? Luke 22:42, 2 Corinthians 12:7-10
- f) Share a testimony of personal healing.
